ANZAC DAY - 1970

General.

1. It is anticipated that 6 RAR/NZ (ANZAC) Bn will have completed operations and W Coy will have been relieved at the Horseshoe by 24 Apr 70.
2. It is proposed to hold a combined ANZAC DAY and MEMORIAL DAWN SERVICE and a farewell Battalion Parade on 25 Apr 70 at NUI DAT.

Sequence of Events.

3. The proposed sequence is:
 - a. 24 Apr 70.
 - (1) Battalion return to NUI DAT from Op TOWNSVILLE completed AM.
 - (2) Battalion Parade rehearsal - PM.
 - (3) COs Address to Battalion - PM.
 - b. 25 Apr 70.
 - (1) Combined ANZAC Day and Memorial Dawn Service (See Annex A for Format).
 - (2) Gunfire Breakfast.
 - (3) Battalion Parade (See Annex B for Format).
 - (4) Coy Luncheon.
 - (5) Make and Mend.

Dress.

4. The dress for the Dawn Service is to be:
 - a. Clean greens JG.
 - b. Hats KFF or Green Beret, as applicable.
 - c. Personal Weapons.
5. The dress for the Battalion Parade is to be:
 - a. Shirts JG, starched.
 - b. Trousers JG, starched (drawstrings to be inserted and worn).
 - c. Ribbons of orders, awards and decorations.

- d. Laneyards.
- e. Sashes scarlet infantry, as applicable.
- f. Boots GP, highly polished and square laced.
- g. Belts pistols and sidearms (pistols to be worn on the left side).
- h. Personal weapons.
- i. Hats KFF or Green Beret, as applicable.

6. All companies are to make the maximum effort to have haircuts completed by PM 24 Apr 70.

Rehearsals.

7. No rehearsal will be required for the Dawn Service. See Annex A. There will however, be a rehearsal conducted for the Battalion Parade, at a time to be stipulated, on 24 Apr 70. This parade will also include an address by CO 6 RAR/NZ(ANZAC) Bn.

 - (3) Eagle Farm 24 Apr 70. Time to be advised.
- b. QM - provision of rum for Gunfire Breakfast.
- c. Sp Coy - Clean area Bn HQ Flag Station by 241800H.
- d. Admin Coy. -
 - (1) Prepare surface EAGLE FARM for parade by 241300H.
 - (2) Provision of dais at Bn Parade and entrance to D Coy.
- e. Adjt - Liaison with PR for coverage.
- f. RP Sect - Establish road block at Eagle Farm and V Coy to deny vehicle entry by 251030H.
- g. WO Asst Admin. - Mark Flag station and Bn Parade Ground. Provide Aust and NZ National Flags. Provide lecturn and Bn Flags at Flag Station for Dawn Service.
- h. Capt Brock - Escort Comd 1 ATF to 6 RAR Offrs Mess on conclusion of Battalion March Past.
- i. All Companies - Flags to be flown at half mast from first light 25 Apr 70 until 251200H.

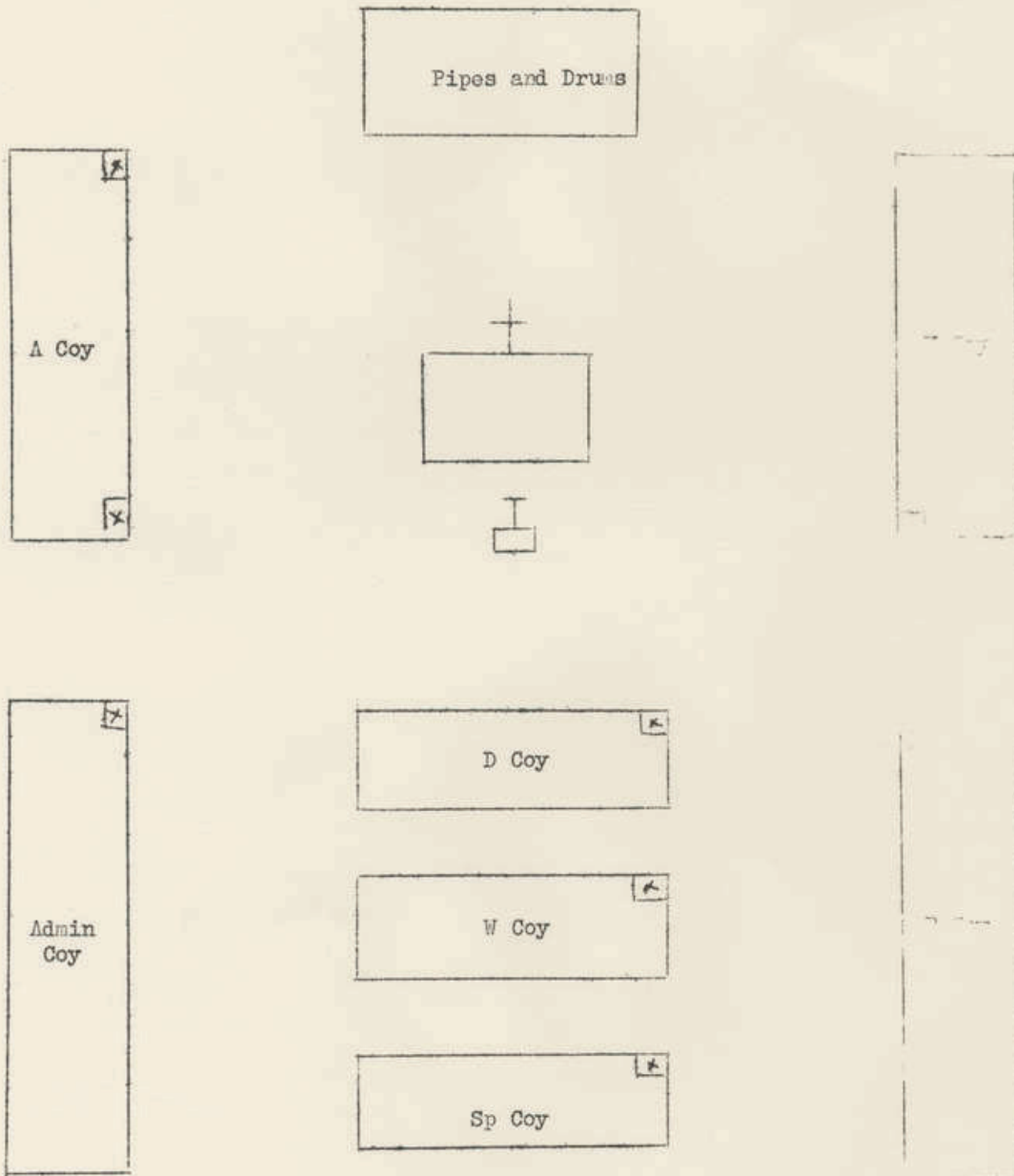
