

1. Report by: 337670 Sgt J.B. YANDALL 2 RAR/NZ W Coy 3 Pl.
2. Date/Time of contact: 101455H Sep 70. Grid Location: YS244795.
3. Duration of (i) Firefight: 5 min (ii) Total: 25 mins
4. Description of contact: Pl moved on north-south track when signal from rear of pl indicated that VC was sighted moving across swamp which was north of the track. After a period of two minutes, firing was opened up by the lead section who had detected movement to their immediate front.
5. Description of terrain and canopy: Secondary jungle, visibility 5 metres.
6. Who first saw enemy: Lead scout, M79 number.
7. Distance enemy first sighted: 5 metres.
8. What caused enemy to be noticed: Noise and direct sighting.
9. Strengths: Enemy: Unknown Own troops 31.
10. Enemy Type: NVA.
11. Who fired first: Lead scout and M79 number.
12. Range of first engagement: 5 metres.
13. Maximum range of engagement: 25 metres
14. Weapons fired: Friendly M60; M16; SLR. Enemy AK 47


